It is time once again to conduct the annual emergency procedures training and evacuation drill this coming Thursday, August 31st, at 5:00 pm.

For those who have not attended in years past, we receive training on what to do for various emergency scenarios from Sure Path Solutions, our emergency procedures consultant. We then simulate an emergency alarm for the building and conduct a voluntary evacuation of the residents. This is a great opportunity to refresh on our emergency procedures and the emergency exits available to residents.

Bag Your Trash

There have been increasing instances of loose trash coming down the trash chutes and creating a mess in the trash rooms on P1. We would like to remind you to please bag your trash and to make sure any liquids or other potential hazards are properly contained before they are thrown down the chutes.

Individual Water Alarms

Given the large number of water leaks that occur in the building, we want to remind you that we have individual water alarms that are available for purchase at the Front Desk. At \$10 each, these are an inexpensive way to detect a minor leak before it becomes a more serious issue. It is recommended to place an alarm in any area that has the potential for a water leak. This includes areas under the sinks and refrigerator, behind toilets, washing machines, and hot water heaters, etc.
