A few important updates before we embark on the weekend.

Garage Wifi:

A reminder that we will have workers in the garage on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday of next week running wiring throughout the garage. Please be EXTRA cognizant while driving through the garage.

Elevator Modification Update:

Due to some delays attributed to the button manufacturer, the start date has been pushed back for the elevator modernization project. The current updated schedule has us craning the machinery up to the roof in mid-July with the modifications scheduled to start the second week of August.

Mainly Mozart:

Don't forget to RSVP for the June 10th Mainly Mozart Wine Reception with entertainment by a few of the Mainly Mozart musicians right here at Park Laurel. The Wine Reception will be held in the South Lobby from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm followed by music in the North Lobby.

Pool Deck:

As the existing surface coating of the pool deck reaches its life expectancy, the Board and Architectural Committee has decided that installing a nonslip tile around the deck, ramp, and the area outside of the Prado Room will be a more durable longer lasting material that is also more aesthetic than what was originally installed. In order to complete this project, the pool deck will be closed much of June and we will send you additional updates as we get more details on the actual start date.

Rock & Roll Marathon:

We wanted to inform you that the Rock & Roll Marathon is just around the corner and set to take place on June 1st and June 2nd. Please see the detailed information below for street closures.

Saturday 5K:

The race starts at 7:00 am and Sixth Avenue will be closed off until 10:00 am. Heavy pedestrian traffic is expected to impact the building between 5:30 am and 7:45 am. During this time, you will not be able to pull out or pull in to the driveway. After 7:45 am, you will be able to access/exit the building without any issue (Per SDPD's discretion). Please follow SDPD's directions carefully.

Sunday Marathon, 1/2 Marathon & Relay Races:



These races start at 6:15 am on Sunday. The last participant should pass the intersection at roughly 7:20 am. SDPD will likely start allowing cross traffic at this time. Sixth Avenue will remain closed until 10:00 am. Simply tell the officer that you live in the building and they should allow access.

If you need to exit the building during the time that the building is impacted, we recommend that you park in the CHASE garage overnight so you can leave without any problems. Please see the attached flyers for exact street closures.
